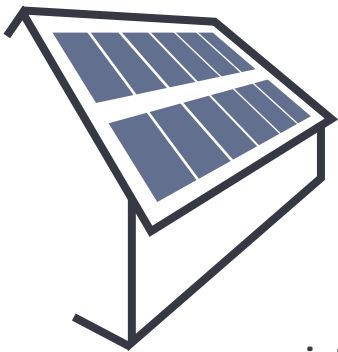


What is net metering and how does it work?

Net metering allows owners of solar panels to contribute excess power back into the grid while saving on future electricity bills



Owners of solar panels generate electricity by using the sun's energy

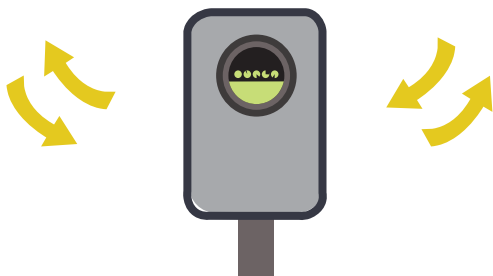


That electricity gets used in homes, schools, and businesses, but solar panels often generate more energy than is needed



Net metering allows that excess energy to flow back into the grid for others to use

Owners of solar panels that net meter can receive credit for the excess energy



With a net metering device, we can measure the flow of energy through electrical meters, tracking how much energy is consumed and how much is sent back into the grid

Wyoming State Legislators set regulations that determine which properties qualify for net metering and how much to credit them for the energy they send to others in the grid
