



Facts on solar incentives

Statewide

Blue Sky Community Project Grants

- Available for community-based projects at schools, food banks, houses of worship, municipal buildings and nonprofits.
- Reviews grants 2x per year.

Bank of the West, Energy Efficient Discount

- Get .25% off of a Home Equity Credit Loan when financing energy efficiency updates in your home.
- Loan discount available for home improvement and energy upgrades.

Federal

Solar Investment Tax Credit (ITC)

- A 26% tax credit for solar systems on residential (under Section 25D) and commercial (under Section 48) properties.
- Allows homeowner to apply credit to federal income taxes if solar system is owned outright.

FannieMae Green Financing Loan Program

- Low-interest loan for multi-family dwellings for energy-saving improvements, like solar.

Rural Energy for America Program (REAP) Loan Guarantees & Grants

- Funds up to 75% of the cost of solar agricultural or rural business installation projects through grants (up to 25%) or loans (up to 75%).

FHA Power Saver Loan Program

- Federally insured low-interest loans to provide funding to power-saving home improvements, including solar systems.
